Requests from freelancers must be accompanied by a letter from the organization that they represent for the National Bank Cup. Tennis Canada and the WTA reserve the right to approve or reject accreditation requests. Sending an application does not guarantee acceptance. After the deadline, you will receive a written confirmation by e-mail regarding the status of your application.

EACH ACCREDITATION MUST BE CLAIMED BY THE PERSON FOR WHOM IT HAS BEEN GRANTED, UPON PRESENTATION OF IDENTIFICATION.

- Accreditation solely given out to media on duty and covering the event.
- Only journalists with daily deadlines will be given reserved seating in the press gallery.
- No generic accreditations will be accepted.

Accredited photographers and cameramen must respect the following rules:

It is strictly prohibited to:

- Move around in an excessive manner when in proximity to the court during a match;
- Use of a camera with a driving engine during a service or at any moment if the player or referee objects to its use;
- Reposition oneself on the court in an area other than the one that was assigned to you;
- If a player or an official demands that no photographs be taken in a given situation, photographers must comply immediately and unconditionally;
- If there is not enough place for all of the accredited photographers and cameramen on Centre Court, they will alternate their presence at the request of the media manager;
- A photographer cannot ask a player to pose during a match or when she is on route to the court.

Any person who does not adhere to these regulations may be denied the right to access Centre Court and the facilities of the National Bank Cup presented by IGA. Refusal to follow the regulations may result in the revocation of an accreditation by the Communications Manager for Tennis Canada, the representative of the WTA or the tournament director.
